

SHINGLES VACCINE

PRE-SCREENING QUESTIONS

STEP 1 - READ AND ANSWER EACH OF THE QUESTIONS BELOW TO DETERMINE IF YOU ARE A CANDIDATE FOR THE MICONA SHINGLES VACCINE AT THIS TIME.

IMPORTANT: Shingles is caused by the Varicella Zoster virus, the same virus that causes chickenpox. Only someone who has had a case of chickenpox - or received the chickenpox vaccine - can get shingles.

Have you had chickenpox or received the chickenpox vaccine? YES NO

If your answer to the question above is "YES" please continue to answer QUESTIONS 1-10 in Step 2
If you answered "NO" to the question above, then you are not a candidate for the Shingles vaccine at this time. Please consult with your Physician.

STEP 2 PRECAUTIONS and CONTRADICTIONS - Please mark YES or NO for each question below.

- Do you have a life-threatening allergic reaction to gelatin, the antibiotic neomycin, or any other component of shingles vaccine (inactive ingredients include: sucrose, hydrolyzed porcine gelatin, sodium chloride, monosodium L-glutamate, sodium phosphate dibasic, potassium phosphate monobasic, potassium chloride)? YES NO
- Do you have a disease or condition that causes a weakened immune system such as an immune deficiency or any of the following?
- HIV/AIDS or another disease that affects the immune system
- treatment with drugs that affect the immune system, such as steroids
- cancer treatment such as radiation or chemotherapy
- a history of cancer affecting the bone marrow or lymphatic system, such as leukemia or lymphoma YES NO
- Do you have active TB (tuberculosis) that is not being treated? YES NO
- Are you pregnant or may be pregnant? YES NO
- Are you breast-feeding? YES NO
- Are you moderately or severely ill? YES NO
- Do you have a temperature of 101.3 F or higher? YES NO
- Have you received the Shingles Vaccine? YES NO
- Have you had shingles within the last three (3) months? YES NO
- Over the 21 days following the Shingles Immunization, will you be in close contact (including household contact) with someone who may be pregnant or has not had chickenpox or been vaccinated against chickenpox, or someone who has problems with their immune system? YES NO

If you have checked "YES" to any of the above questions, we are not able to provide you the Shingles Vaccine at this time. Please contact your Physician to review your condition and your options.

If each of the boxes in Step 2 are checked "NO", then you are a candidate for the Shingles Vaccine.
